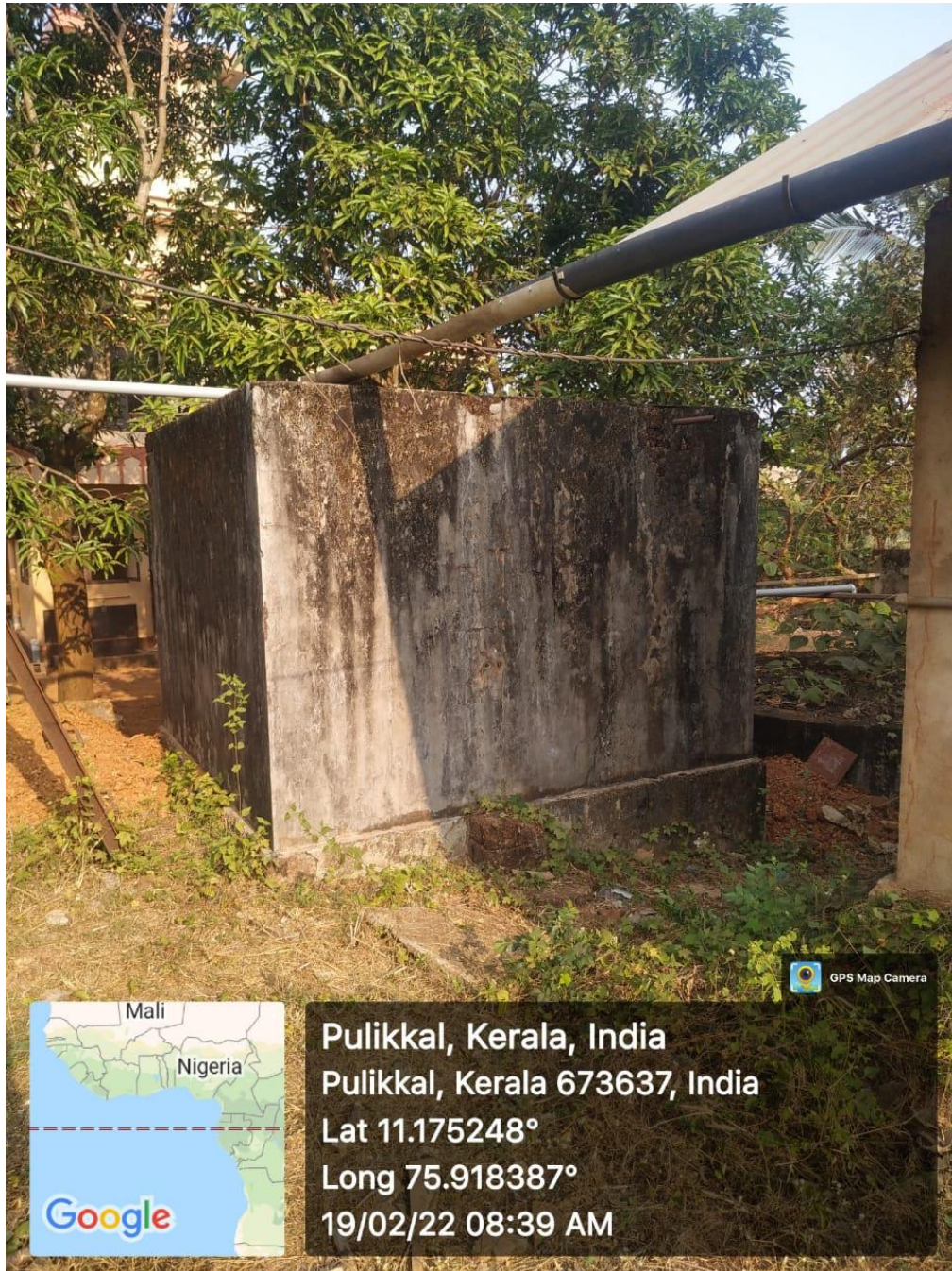

Using waste water for watering Kitchen Gardening



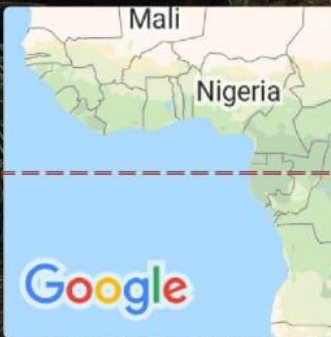
Water conservation facilities available in the College:

Maintenance of water bodies and distribution system in the campus.

A water foundation is built in front of the library using the rainwater. About 800 m away from the campus water bodies under 3.75 sq ft is setup which is used for college purpose. The water from here is distributed to 50,000 litre tank via pumping whereby it is available through 70-80 tapes.
