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WHO WE ARE?

Madeenathul Uloom Arabic College was established in 1947 by Kerala Jamiyyathul Ulama (The ever first organization of Muslim Scholars in Kerala). The College is the culmination of the relentless efforts of reformist Muslim scholars of the 20th Century. MCC Abdu Rahman Moulavi, great educationist and scholar in Islamic disciplines and Arabic language, was the pioneer among them. The ultimate goal envisioned was to empower the socially and educationally backward people hailing from the region, predominantly from the Muslim minority, with modern education and training given in a formal institutional ambience.

The college was originally affiliated to the University of Madras and was recognized by Kerala University in 1957. The college has been affiliated to the University of Calicut since 1968 since the commencement of the university. At present M.U.A. College is a full-fledged Post graduate college offering M.A. Post Afzal ul Ulama, B.A programmes in Economics, Afzal UI Ulama and Functional Arabic. The Post Graduate Department of Arabic has been upgraded as a research centre since June 2010. The college was included under the 2(f) 12(B) Act of the UGC on 27/04/2010.

The college has succeeded in realizing the objectives envisaged by K.J.U at its inception. The graduates who passed out from the college for the last 75 years are placed in responsible and prestigious position home and abroad. They also play a pivotal role in the society in the educational, cultural, social and religious scenario. SALIENT FEATURES

RESEARCH CENTER

Research Centre facilitates fully furnished reading space for scholars, vast collections of reference materials and 3 computers with internet connection to access e-resources.

SEMINAR HALL

The college has a Seminar Hall with ICT facilities to conduct seminars and workshops. The ICT can be used for students to watch lectures of eminent scholars from different parts of the world.

SHEIKH ZAYED LIBRARY

Madeenathul Uloom Arabic College Library is considered as one of the oldest libraries in South India having more than 15000 books, 6000 journals, 1,64,300 e-books and numerous online journals and magazines in Arabic, English, Urdu and Malayalam. It has a rare collection of manuscripts in Arabic, Urdu and Persian languages. The library is automated with latest automation software KOHA, An Integrated Library Management Software and has access to INFLIBNET - N-List Programme under the Ministry of Education Govt. of India.



Informatics Center & Language Lab

The College has a full-fledged Informatics Centre with 50 computers with Internet connectivity. The student-computer ratio of the institution is 6.9: 1. The Informatics Centre offers certificate courses in MS Office, MS Word, DTP etc.

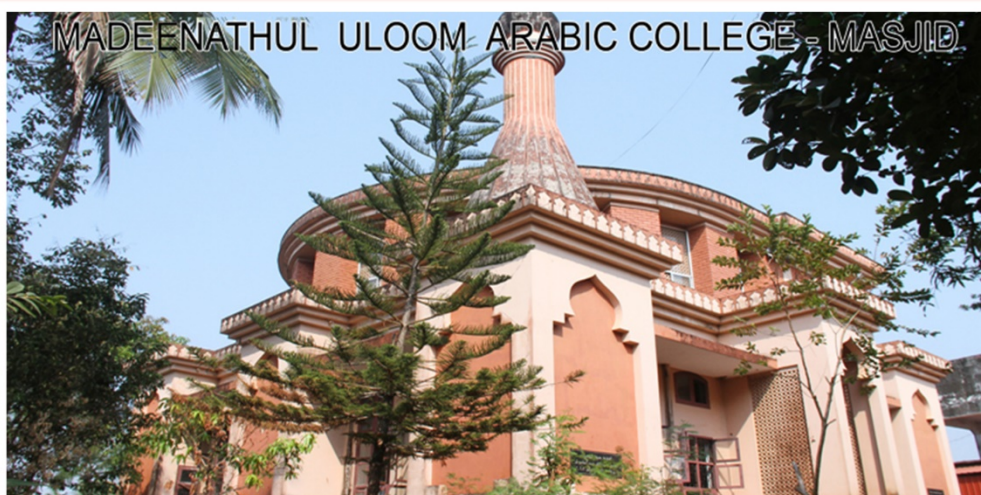


College Hostel

GIRLS RECREATION ROOM

GIRLS RETIRING ROOM

Since college has so many girls' students, the college maintains separate retiring room for them. A comfortable room, that is soothingly furnished with a single bed, mattress, bed-sheet and a pillow, a covering sheet/ blankets, curtains and fan. A small table and chair are placed therewith provision of drinking water.

FITNESS CENTRE

Education can be a challenging time for many students. Social and academic pressures can create stress and anxiety. Channeling that stress into fitness is a healthy way to unwind and improve overall health. Focusing on the above, the institution maintains a fitness Center inside the campus for physical activities. so, the students can do cardiac and weight training in their leisure time.



CODE OF ETHICS

1. Class timings will be from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm. Students must be present in all their classes.
2. Students will not be allowed to college premises without wearing college ID Card.
3. Students should be neat, tidy and modest in dressing and personal appearance.
4. During the time of national anthem all should stand in perfect silence and discipline.
5. Students should not go outside the college during class hours. In the event of unavoidable necessity, they should seek special permission from the Head of the Department/Class teacher.
6. Students should not engage themselves in actions that are offensive that harm fellow students in the campus.
7. Any act, in any form, against a new entrant of the college, will be treated as Ragging and the accused will be made liable for punishment as per the Indian Penal Code. Ragging of any form is a non-bailable offence and requires criminal procedure. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, severe action will be taken against such students and the matter will be forwarded to the police for further action under criminal procedure. They will be forbidden from pursuing their studies in any other institution for five years.
8. Possession and use of tobacco, panparag, drugs, liquor and such other intoxication items are strictly prohibited inside the campus.
9. All are strictly prohibited from participating in any agitation, strike, dharna, gherao and in such activities which will disturb the classes or endanger the peaceful atmosphere of the campus.
10. Outsiders are not permitted to attend or organise any programme or activity without the permission of the principal. No student shall invite or entertain such outsiders. Entry for media persons is allowed only with the prior permission from the principal.
11. The principal will have the right to issue Transfer Certificate to a student without an application from the student or the guardian at any time during the course of his/her study in the college on the violation of college rules.
12. The principal will have the power to inflict the following punishments: suspension, compulsory issue of T.C. and expulsion.
13. The principal reserves the right to take punitive measures which include suspension/dismissal from the college/hostel, compulsory issue of TC, imposing of fine, refusal of permission to apply for examination and forwarding of the complaint to the police.
14. The principal shall be the final authority in interpretation of the college rules. Matters not covered by these rules are left to the discretion of the principal and his decisions shall be final.
15. The principal or other duly constituted college or hostel authorities will have the right to frame and issue from time-to-time disciplinary rules regulating the conduct of students within and outside the College and the Hostel premises with a view to maintaining the credit and reputation of the college and the hostels.
16. Promotion to a higher class, selection for semester end examinations and issue of progress, attendance or conduct certificates are matters absolutely within the discretion of the principal.
17. Students should desist from disfiguring the classrooms, compound walls and buildings on the college campus by pasting posters or writing on them. They should also desist from disfiguring the compound walls of neighbouring buildings.
18. Organizational Activities of the student: As per the judgement of the Honourable High Court of Kerala, the Principal has the right to control the organizational activities of student organizations on the campus.
19. All expressions or activities which are immoral, anti-social, communal and anti-national are strictly prohibited in the college.

LIBRARY RULES

1. Library works from 09.00 a.m. to 08.00 p.m. except on Sundays and Public Holidays.
2. All the teaching and non-teaching staff, guest faculty, research scholars, and students are eligible to take membership in the library.
3. The members are entitled to borrow books and other documents using their College ID cards.
4. The check out and check in process of documents will be regulated according to the time schedule and procedures stipulated by the librarian
5. No member should keep a book for more than a fortnight. It may be reissued to the same member if there is no other reservation on it.
6. Absence from the college will not be admitted as an excuse for the delay in returning books.
7. The librarian may recall a book at any time even when the normal period of loan is not over.
8. Members should not sub lend the books with each other. Members should replace books lost, or pay for them a price to be fixed by the Principal.
9. If the date on which a book is due to be returned falls on a holiday should be returned on the very next working day.
10. Ordinarily books will not be issued to non- members. In exceptional cases the Principal may permit a non-member to have access to the library or to borrow books on such terms as the Principal determines.
11. A fine of Rs. 1.00 per day will be levied if a book is detained beyond the due date.
12. Internet and digital library consumption will be regulated according to scheduled timings and procedures.
13. Absolute silence and cleanliness should be maintained in the library.
14. Used books should not be replaced on the shelf without the help of librarian, but keep on the reading table.
