## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

and

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) is made on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2016, between Madeenathul Uloom Arabic College (MUAC), Pulikkal and Anvarul Islam Women's Arabic College (AIWAC), Mongam, Malappuram as the renewal of the MoU dated first June 2016 and may be amended only by written agreement signed by each of the parties involved.

### 1. Field of cooperation

- b) Promote appropriate joint research projects.
- c) Conduct study camps and workshops that facilitate learning activity.
- d) Conduct seminars, workshops, international conferences to share expertise and knowledge that renew motivation and confidence.
- e) Faculty and student exchange programmes in fields of mutual interests.

The aim of the MOU shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both campuses. As per the agreement the terms and condition given hereunder are binding for both institutions.


1. The host institution is to assist the other in the seeking of appropriate housing, and to supply work space, library and technical facilities as appropriate.
2. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party is to be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the programme.
3. Both parties agree to the shared use of facilities including classrooms, office and library facilities that reduces operating costs and promotes collaboration of students, faculty, staff, and community members in program success.

## 2. Validation period of this MoU

1. This MoU shall be valid for the period of five years from the execution of the same, unless the parties mutually agree in writing to extend the same.
2. This MoU can be terminated by either party upon written notice of not less than six months.
