d) Conduct seminars, workshops, international conferences to share expertise and knowledge that renew motivation and confidence.

e) Faculty and student exchange programmes in fields of mutual interests.

The aim of the MOU shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both campuses.


The host institution agrees to assist in the seeking of appropriate housing, and to supply work space, library and technical facilities as appropriate.

In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the programme.


Agree to the shared use of facilities including classrooms, office and library facilities that reduces operating costs and promotes collaboration of students, faculty, staff, and community members in program success.

2. Validation period of this MoU

1. This MoU shall be valid for the period of three (3) years from the execution of the same, unless the parties mutually agree in writing to extend the same.
2. This MoU can be terminated by either party upon written notice of not less than ninety (90) days.
