The college NSS Unit has organized a programme 'blood directory of adopted village: data collection on 03 and 21 November 2017. 35 of our NSS Volunteers participated in the data collection. It was a strong decision taken by us at the meeting in the colony to publish a **Directory** containing the blood group details of the adults (over 18 years of age) in the hundreds of families living in the hills of our partner village. For this purpose, our students collected data from house to house in the area through a home contact campaign that lasted more than two weeks on different days. **Kondotty Municipal Councilor Smt. Geetha** inaugurated the home contact campaign at N. H. Colony. Although we have compiled almost all the important data related to this, due to some technical reasons, we were not able to publish the directory in its complete form as expected.

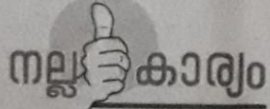
