
DISASTER RELIEF

Severe floods affected the south Indian state Kerala, due to unusually high rainfall during the monsoon season. It was the worst flood in Kerala in nearly a century. During the catastrophic floods that rocked our state during 2018-20, NSS Volunteers of Madeenathul Uloom Arabic College, Pulikkal, were committed to providing the maximum possible support to the flood-affected people regardless of their locality, religion and ideology. As part of this, they visited some disaster relief camps in **Wayanad (Panamaram)** and **Kozhikode (Mukkam)** districts. The inmates of these camps had to account for the damage caused by the heavy flood. At the same time, they took the relief they were experiencing through such relief camps run with the full support of the public.

CHLORINATION, DISINFECTION IN FLOOD-HIT REGIONS OF PARAPPANANGADI

The volunteers of NSS played a major role in disinfection of flooded area, and completed the proposed tasks such as lime sprinkling in backyards and interiors and chlorination in wells.
